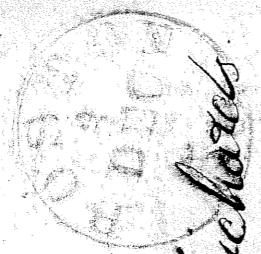

Boston, Nov 29. 1846

My Dear Brother it has been a long time since I have heard from you and I thought I would write you a few lines to let you know that I am well and I hope this will find you the same. Nancy and I are in Boston again and expect to stay until spring, I should have wrote you when I was at home but I could not very well get time there for you must excuse me I had a very pleasant time while at home and I should have been glad could I have seen you for it has been a very long time since I saw you. We had a very hot summer here but there has not been cold weather here yet it has been quite warm to day. It has been very sickly in Boston and in Lincolnville this summer there has been a great many Deaths. I am now living at my old place No 12 Pine Street and when you write direct your letters here I have not much to write now so good bye give my love to your Wife
