Tuesday March 25th she was very bad, looked more like her self than since she was taken sick, but being so swelled there was no chance for life - her legs, feet and thighs were cracked open in quite a number of places - her body a sight to behold - she had pains, drooping, disorder on the brain, Mortification broke out in large spots, but she was calm all the day, spoke of those scenes she had, she said she had had three of them, might come on, pain set in, the night was dreadful, next morning 26th, we were convinced that death had made his final grasp - she appeared like one venturing to sleep last candle, night came on, see she was going fast,

- talked with her about dying, said she knew it, said she could breath her life out sweetly then, meowing, or Jesus be son, and soon she was gone - funeral, Friday one o'clock at Youngtown Schoolhouse house could not hold all present between 1,000 & 1,200 followed to the grave, your letter of the 21st is received, kept photo & peach the office Wednesday evening, but death prevented our sending for it till Saturday, did wish for it one week sooner, said says he shall write after you answer on this, which I hope you will do without fail have you receive a paper wither a year? I must write again soon, know you afflicted father
