 to be done to obtain the money, Resolved
 that the sum of six hundred dollars be
 appropriated for the benefit of schools in
 the Madwaska settlements to be apportioned
 in the following manner namely two hundred
 and ~~dollars~~ and twenty five dollars to Van Buren
 plantation two hundred and twenty five dollars
 to Madwaska plantation and one hundred and
 fifty dollars to Hancock plantation provide
 that each of said plantations shall raise for
 the support of schools within its limits
 a sum equal to the amount hereby
 apportioned to said plantation And whenever
 the assessors of either of said plantations shall
 certify under oath to the treasurer ~~and~~
 of State that the sum herein required
 to be raised by said plantation has ~~been~~
 been so raised and assessed the said
 treasurer is ~~to~~ authorized to pay to
 said assessors the ~~sum~~ amount above
 apportioned to said plantation to be
