Dear Sir

Should I not go down to  
the Convention, will you see some of  
the Crookfolk folks about votes, when I  
was down I forgot to speak about it -

tower", to distribute votes &c. & to do all  
other things necessary to the further-  
ance of our cause - I see by  
my papers that the "Sham Democracy"  
are secretly at work with the ex-  
pectation of carrying the State  
by surprise - I may come down  
with if I can - make as judicious  
a nomination as circumstances will  
allow - Some of our friends should  
see Mr. McGurk the Priest with  
regard to our Election -
