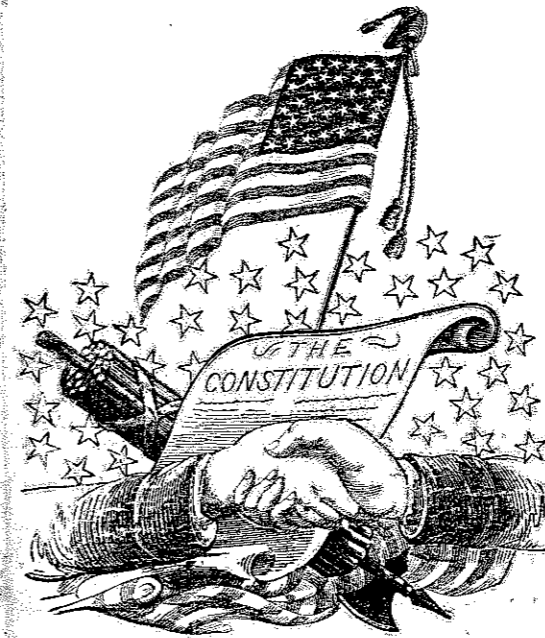

 100 horses and they are coming
 every day there is also part
 of 2 Regt of infantry on
 the other side of us

John B. Godard is at

 our company from Bangor
 is the first company being
 company D and we have
 the right of the Regt
