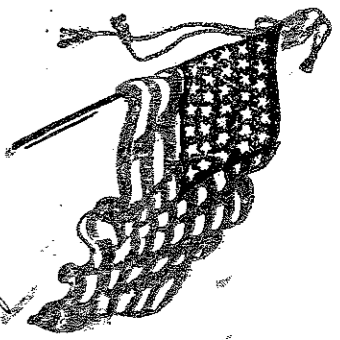

By Order Appraisd March 16 1861;

Three hundred dollars was appropriated for repairing the "State road in township of Range Two."

It has been delayed for the purpose of accumulating sufficient road funds to conform with the money and Seers as you would express the term.

There has been thought exclusively incurred as we may not look for additional appropriations for road purposes, and it is hoped that with the view of the money the road may be completed up to the standard required and when investigation you shall find this can be done you are hereby authorized
