 but did not take up the

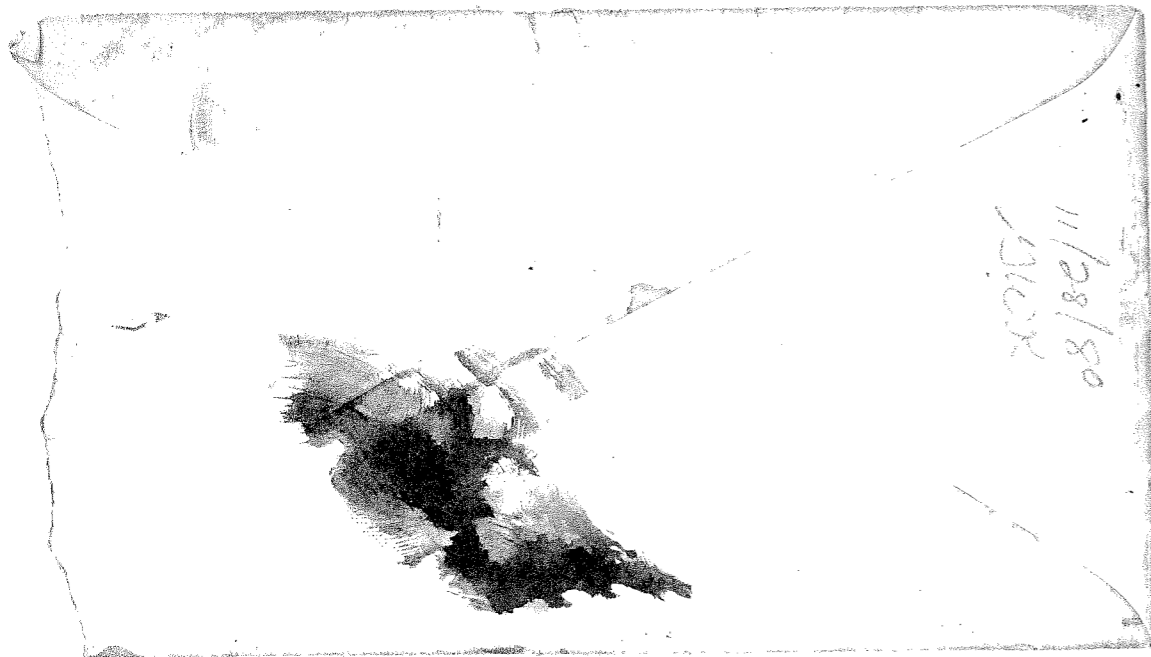
 note. concluded to wait
