## Regional Student Program/Tuition Break Participating Colleges and Universities 2013-14 Annual Full-Time UNDERGRADUATE Tuition Rates

**KEY. All tuition rates are tuition only, excluding fees, room and board.**

**IN** = *in-state tuition* charged to students who are permanent residents of the state where the college is located.

**OUT** = *out-of-state tuition* charged to students who live outside the state where the college is located.

**DISCOUNT** = reduction off out-of-state tuition provided to RSP-eligible students.

**TUITION: RSP** = *tuition* charged to RSP-eligible out-of-state students from other New England states.
