## UMPI Athletic Training Program Communicable Diseases

The dispensation of athletic training students who are suffering from communicable diseases will be dealt with on a case-by-case basis. The general principles guiding these decisions are: (1) the health of the athletic training student and (2) the health of the physically active patients represent the paramount concerns. As a result, athletic training students will be removed from clinical activity while they are contagious or while they job performance represents a hazard to their health or the health of the physically active patients they may come in contact with during the normal course of their educational day.

Students must report to the health center when ill during their clinical rotation. The Health center health care provider will notify the Dean of Students office. The Dean of Student's office will notify all instructors and advisors (Program Director). The student is still required to inform their ACI/CI as well. All Athletic Training Students must be cleared by the health center health care provider before returning to their clinical rotation, a follow up email will follow clearance.
